The Envirothon is North America's largest environmental education competition for high school students, focusing on five main topics: soils, wildlife, water resources, forestry, and a current environmental issue. During the competition, a natural resource professional presents each topic at a station, followed by a 20-point test. High school teams (grades 9-12) are required to deliver an oral presentation on the Current Issue Scenario: "Roots & Resiliency: Fostering Forest Stewardship in a Canopy of Change." Study guides are provided to help students prepare for the competition.

the top three teams at the area competition will advance to the Minnesota State Envirothon Competition on May 19th, 2025 at the Wolf Environmental Learning Center in Finland, MN
